



Hi! I'm Tina

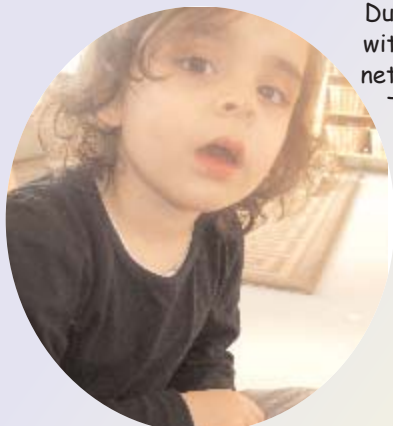
I'm four years old. I need a family who can adopt me.

Tina presents as a vivacious little girl who is full of life. She is gregarious and constantly on the go, although she does have significant global delay. Tina has very limited speech but is able to make herself understood and to get her needs met.

Due to her significant needs, Tina would ideally be better placed with a two-parent family or a single carer with a reliable support network. A statement of educational needs is being pursued for Tina. Speech and language therapy has been recommended.



Tina is full of life and her carers describe her as being a whirlwind. She needs constant attention. Despite her learning difficulties, Tina is a very independent little girl. She will dress herself and initiate play. Tina has a very good routine and responds well to it. At night, she likes to have a story read to her. At mealtimes, she eats well and particularly likes fruit.



Tina goes to nursery 5 days a week in the mornings. She had a tendency to lash out and scratch other children but these incidents have decreased significantly following intervention by her foster carers and nursery. Tina finds interaction with other children difficult at times and she will take herself off and play on her own. However, she does have the ability to make attachments.
